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05 _ Editorial workflow

Every manuscript passes through the following stages. Authors are notified at each step:

- 1 Submission**
The manuscript is received and registered by the system
- 2 Plagiarism check**
Screened with Copyleaks — originality of at least 70% required
- 3 AI detection**
The degree of AI-generated content is assessed
- 4 Language editing**
Grammatical and stylistic errors are identified and corrected
- 5 Peer review**
The manuscript undergoes independent peer review
- 6 Payment**
After the checks, payment details are sent to the author
- 7 DOI**
The article receives a DOI via Crossref
- 8 Publication**
The article is published on the journal website
- 9 PDF + certificate**
The author receives the final PDF, certificate and confirmation letter
- 10 Indexing**
The article is automatically delivered to international databases
- 11 Issue release**
The monthly issue is released on the 5th of each month

07 _ Manuscript structure

Following this order matters — it lets our automated system process your manuscript correctly. Do not change the sequence given in the template:

01	Article title	in the main language, in capital letters, on its own line
02	Author blocks	full name → affiliation → e-mail → ORCID; each on its own line
03	Scientific adviser	if any — on one line starting with “Ilmiy rahbar:”
04	Abstract and keywords	in the main language of the article only
05	Main text	INTRODUCTION → MATERIALS AND METHODS → RESULTS → DISCUSSION → CONCLUSION
06	References	APA style, numbered list
07	Information in other languages	at the very end of the article, in a separate block

08 _ Language rules

Only the main-language information appears at the beginning of the article. Translations of the title, authors and abstract into other languages go in the block “ARTICLE INFORMATION IN OTHER LANGUAGES” at the **very end** of the article:

Article language	At the beginning	In the closing block
Uzbek	Uzbek title, authors, abstract, keywords	In English and Russian
Russian	Russian title, authors, abstract, keywords	In English
English	English title, authors, abstract, keywords	In Russian

Do not change the labels (**Abstract:**, **Keywords:**, **Title:**, **Authors:**, **Название:**, **Аннотация:** etc.) — the system reads them automatically.

09 _ Author information

Each author's details are written on **separate lines**: full name on one line, affiliation on another, e-mail on another, ORCID on another. With two or more authors the blocks follow one another. **The first author is treated as the corresponding author** — there is no need to add * or any other marker to the name line:

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The name line carries the name only — titles, academic degrees and words such as “student” or “MA candidate” belong on the affiliation line. A scientific adviser goes on a single line: **Ilmiy rahbar: Family Name First Name, PhD, Associate Professor, Institution**

10 _ Equations, figures and tables

Equations

Typed in Word's equation editor (Insert → Equation). Equations pasted as images are not accepted. Equations referenced in the text are numbered on the right: (1).

Figures

Placed in line with text, at least 300 dpi. A centred caption goes below each figure: “Figure 1. Title”. Essential text must not be locked inside images.

Tables

Real Word tables only (not images). The caption goes above the table: “Table 1. Title”. Every table, equation and figure must be referred to in the text.

11 _ References

References follow APA (American Psychological Association) style. In-text citations use square brackets: [1], [2]; the list is numbered in the same order. **Sources in Cyrillic or Uzbek script** are supplemented with an English translation in square brackets for international indexing.
