It covers three areas — law and jurisprudence, economics and finance, and the applied and engineering sciences — so that legal analysis, financial modelling and practical engineering solutions appear side by side. Across 6 volumes it has released 71 issues and published 1,748 research articles. The journal follows the principles of the Budapest Open Access Initiative (BOAI) and is a signatory of the San Francisco Declaration on Research Assessment (DORA): an article is judged on its scholarly content and quality rather than on journal-level metrics, and everything published is freely available to readers without restriction. The editorial office runs on an AI-assisted automated publishing platform: plagiarism screening, grammar and language editing, independent peer review, a DOI for every article and international indexing form a single continuous workflow.

File format	Microsoft Word (.docx) only. PDFs and scans are not accepted
Font	Cambria or Times New Roman, 12 pt
Line spacing	1.15
Page	A4; margins: top/bottom — 2 cm, left — 3 cm, right — 1.5 cm
Length	At least 5 pages (5–12 recommended)
Abstract	150–200 words
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ORCID	Required for every author — as a full link
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06	References	APA style, numbered list
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Only the main-language information appears at the beginning of the article. Translations of the title, authors and abstract into other languages go in the block “ARTICLE INFORMATION IN OTHER LANGUAGES” at the **very end** of the article:

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Typed in Word's equation editor (Insert → Equation). Equations pasted as images are not accepted. Equations referenced in the text are numbered on the right: (1).

Figures

Placed in line with text, at least 300 dpi. A centred caption goes below each figure: “Figure 1. Title”. Essential text must not be locked inside images.

Tables

Real Word tables only (not images). The caption goes above the table: “Table 1. Title”. Every table, equation and figure must be referred to in the text.

References follow APA (American Psychological Association) style. In-text citations use square brackets: [1], [2]; the list is numbered in the same order. **Sources in Cyrillic or Uzbek script** are supplemented with an English translation in square brackets for international indexing.
